


Design a \$10 clock

With a desktop printer, it's easy to transform a nice *ordinary* clock into a *very* nice *one-of-a-kind* clock

Those battery-powered \$10 clocks are light, accurate and easy to read. They're equally easy to take apart and redesign; just pop off the plastic faceplate and hands, pop in your design, and snap it back together.

This ease means you can make clocks for your office, for friends, for marketing messages and even to help you track time zones. Surprise your clients by including a design-coordinated clock in your next presentation; it's inexpensive and original. Make a clock for every occasion! Ideas:



Start by dividing a circle

To fit a letter-size sheet, you'll need a clock face 8 inches or less (be sure to measure before you buy). A tabloid sheet can print a 10.5-inch clock. Clock numbers are 30 degress apart, seconds are 6 degrees apart. Just draw a circle, bisect it with a line, and rotate the line. You'll place your numbers by eye.



• Use numbers sparingly









Color contrasts create depth

Make the most of color contrasts—in this case black, white and two tints of green. Put BIG elements in low contrast, small elements in high contrast. Note how easily small black and white numerals show up against mid-value green, while the big signature is soft.








• Everyone has initials! Make them beautiful

Design a \$10 clock | 4 of 11

- Simple dots mark the hours
- Full name in matching typeface





Soften the contrasts

(Above, left) High-contrast black & white amplifies the huge initials but is somewhat stark. To soften the look, use low-contrast colors—colors with a soft edge when placed next to each other. Silver (gray) and gold convey richness.








- Brighten any room!
- Use a playful typeface!
- Use clear, easy-to-read numbers





Tighten and shift

(Above) Reinforce the playful character of the letters and colors by tightening the spacing and shifting the letters up and down.



Use contrasting typefaces

A plain, bold typeface makes a good contrast to a light, decorative face, because everything about it is different.






Photo clock

- Fun! Great for a product, hobby, classroom

Create space for type

Divide the space in half vertically, horizontally or diagonally; image goes on one side, text on the other. When you have an image without a straight edge, go by its overall mass, and disregard any "whiskers."




Keep up to date



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
