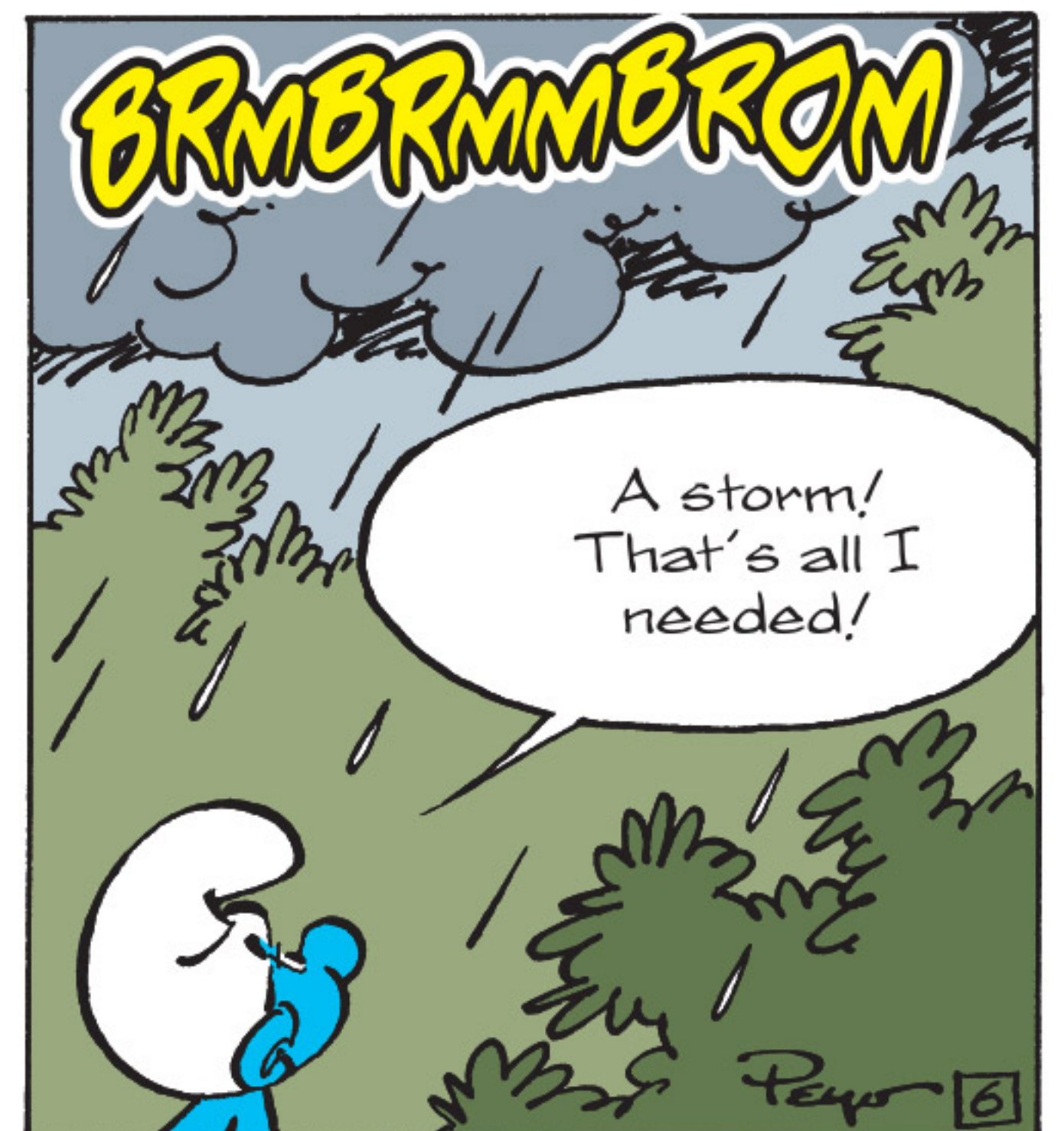
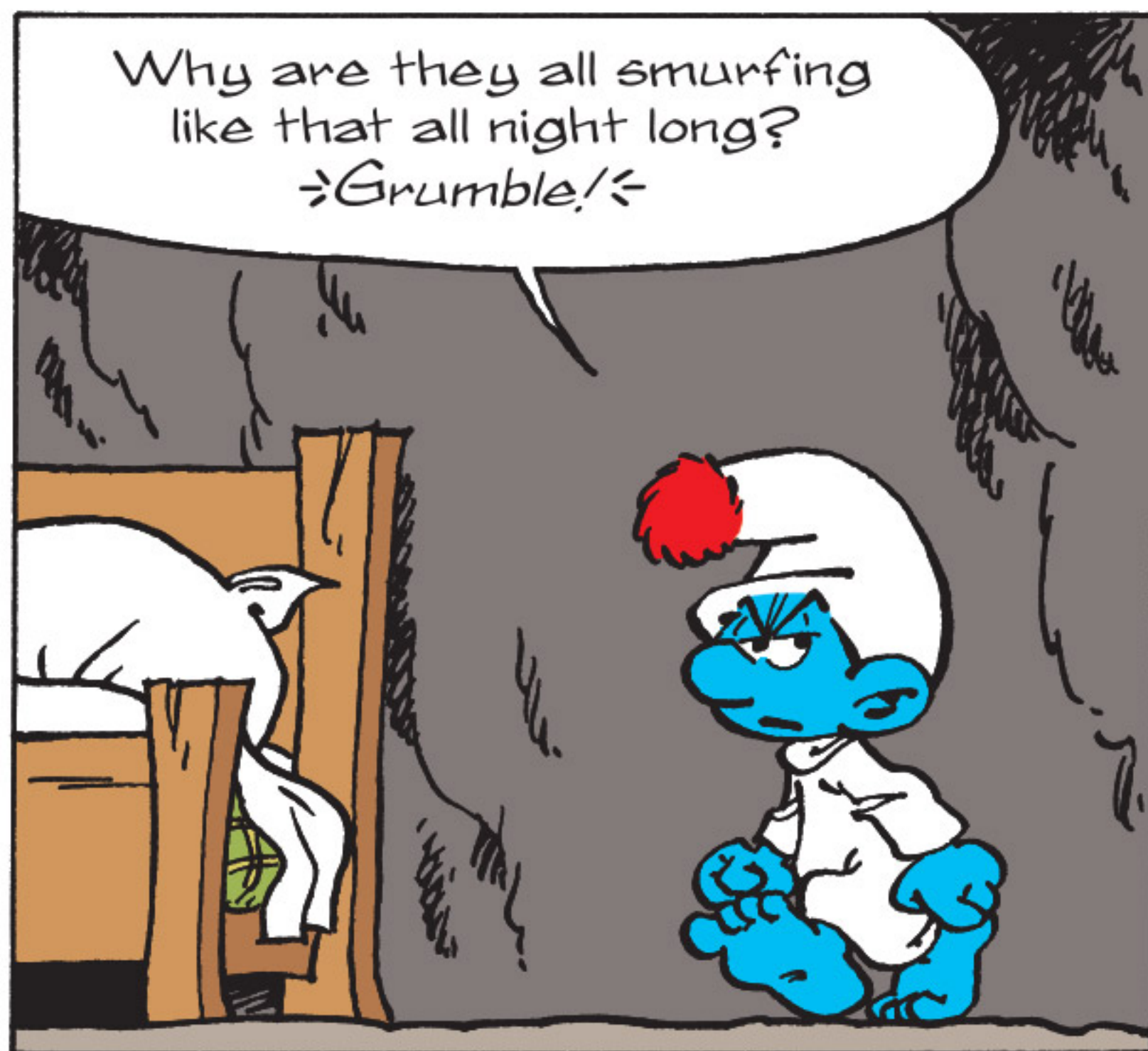
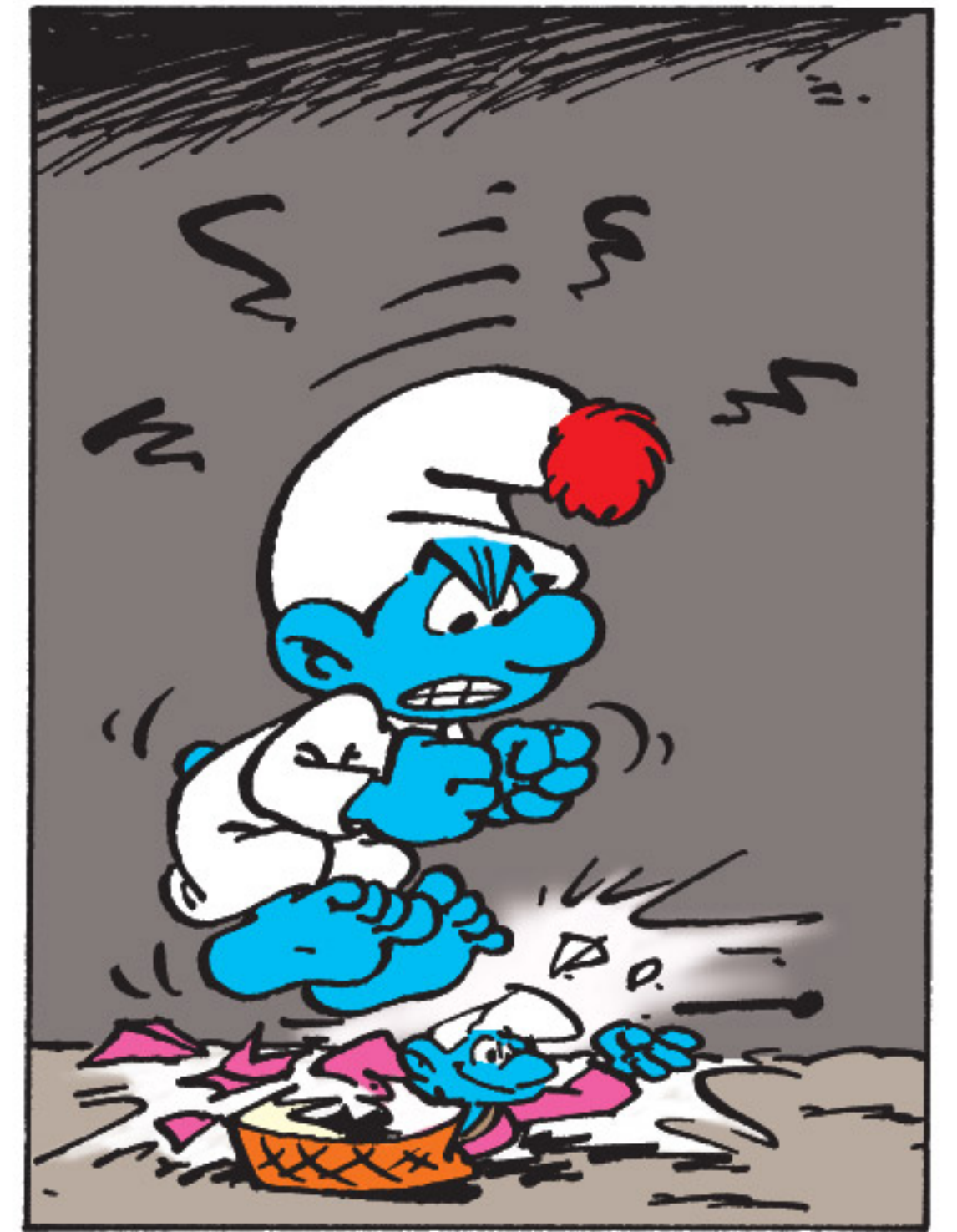
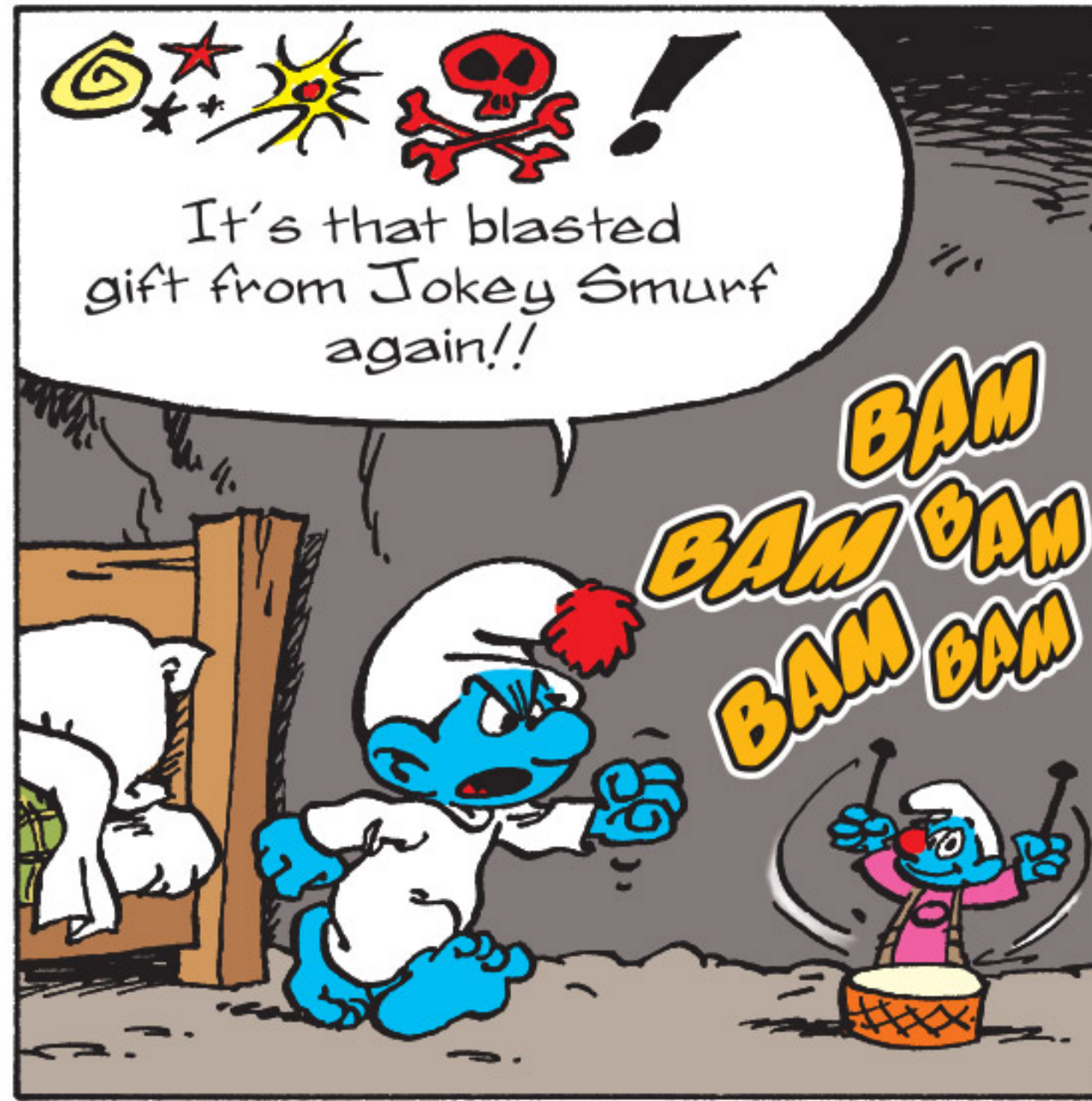


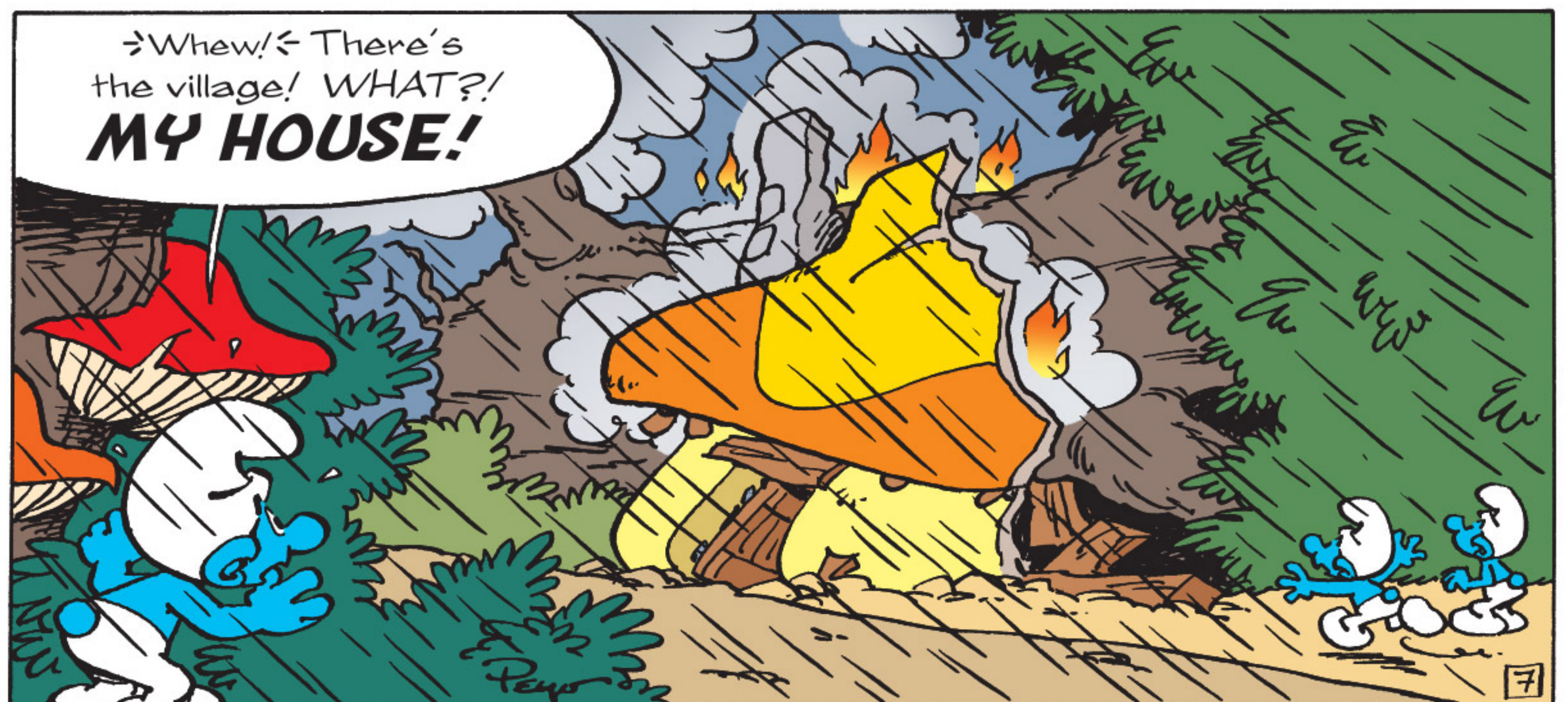
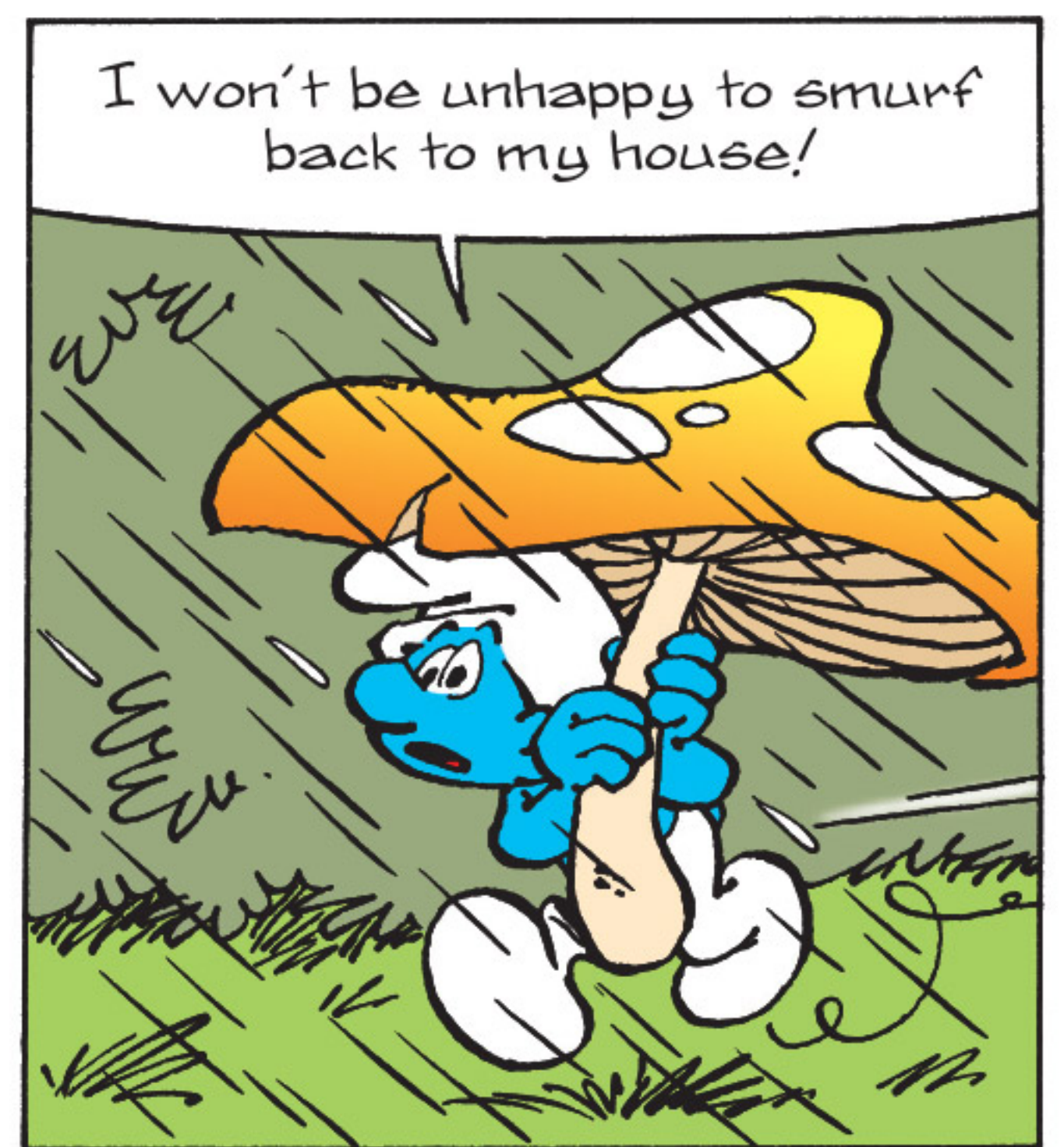
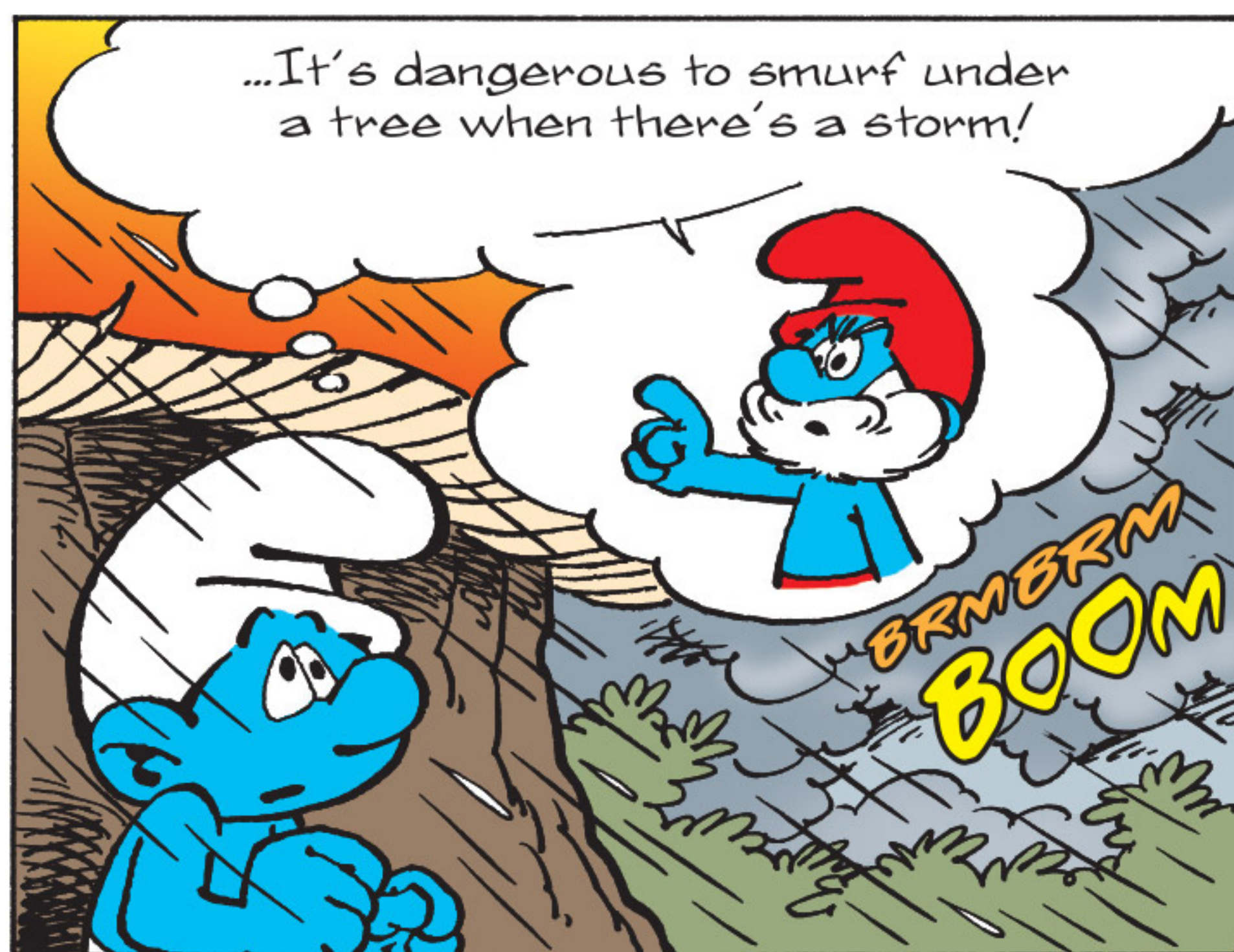
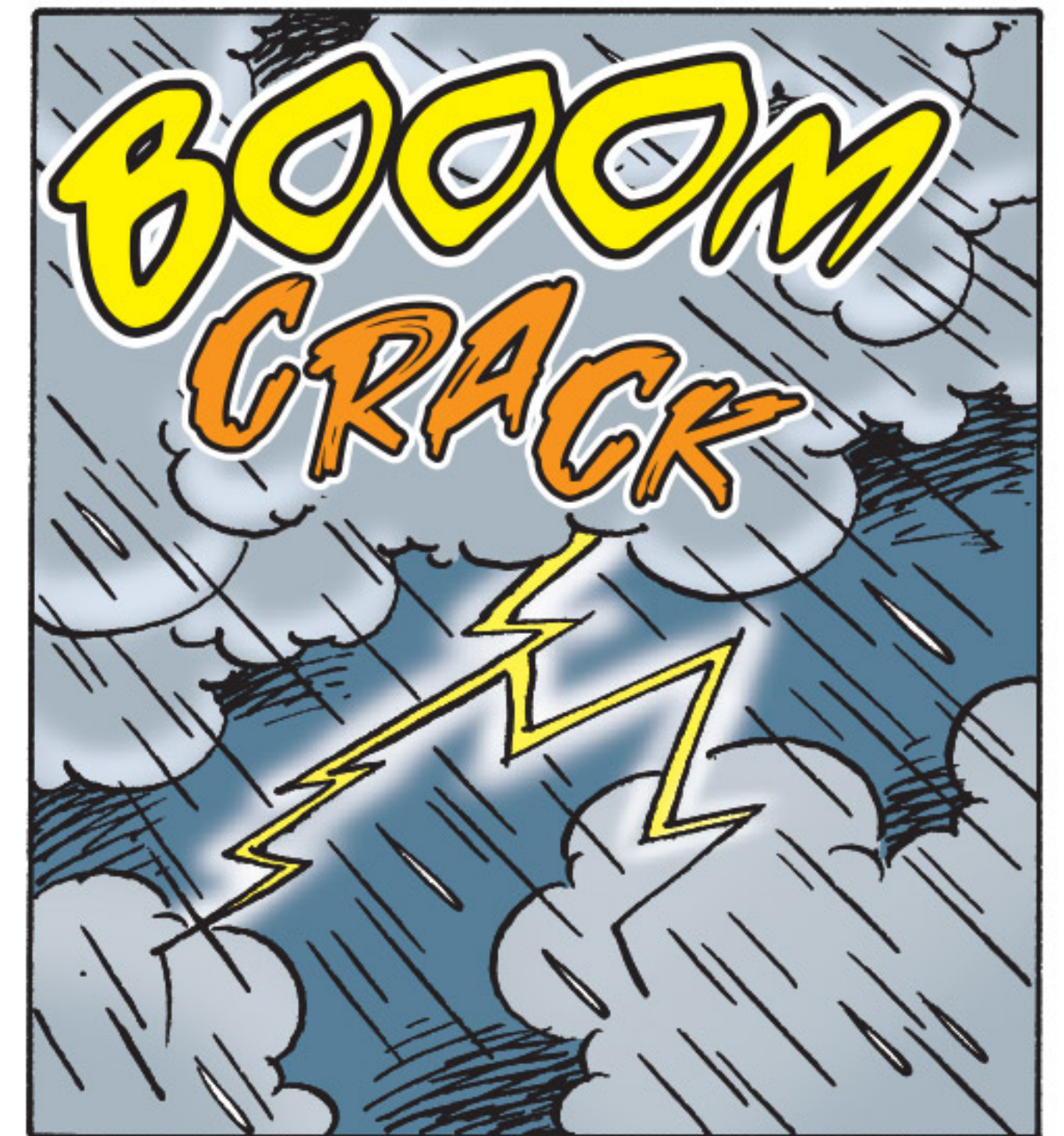
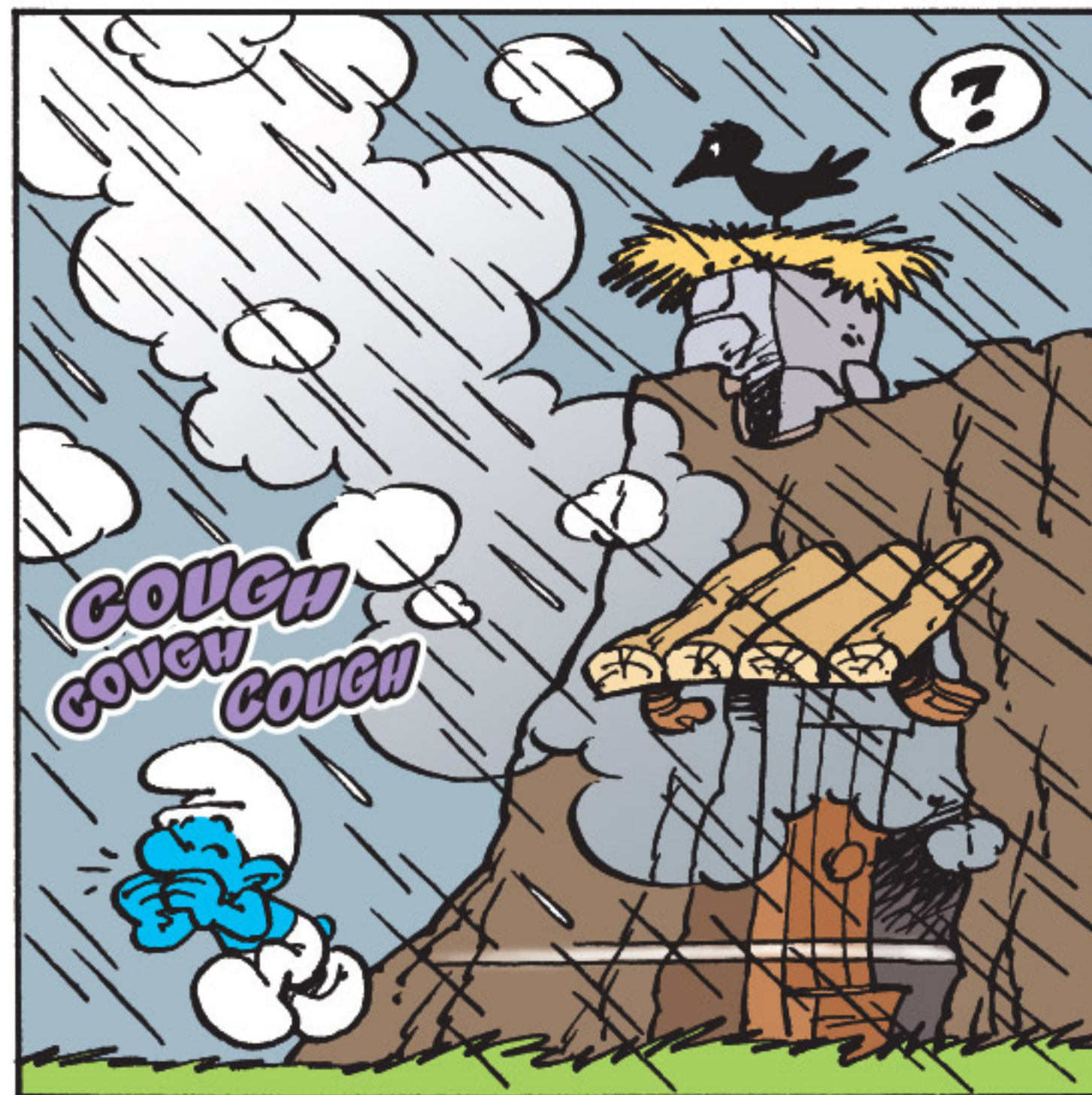
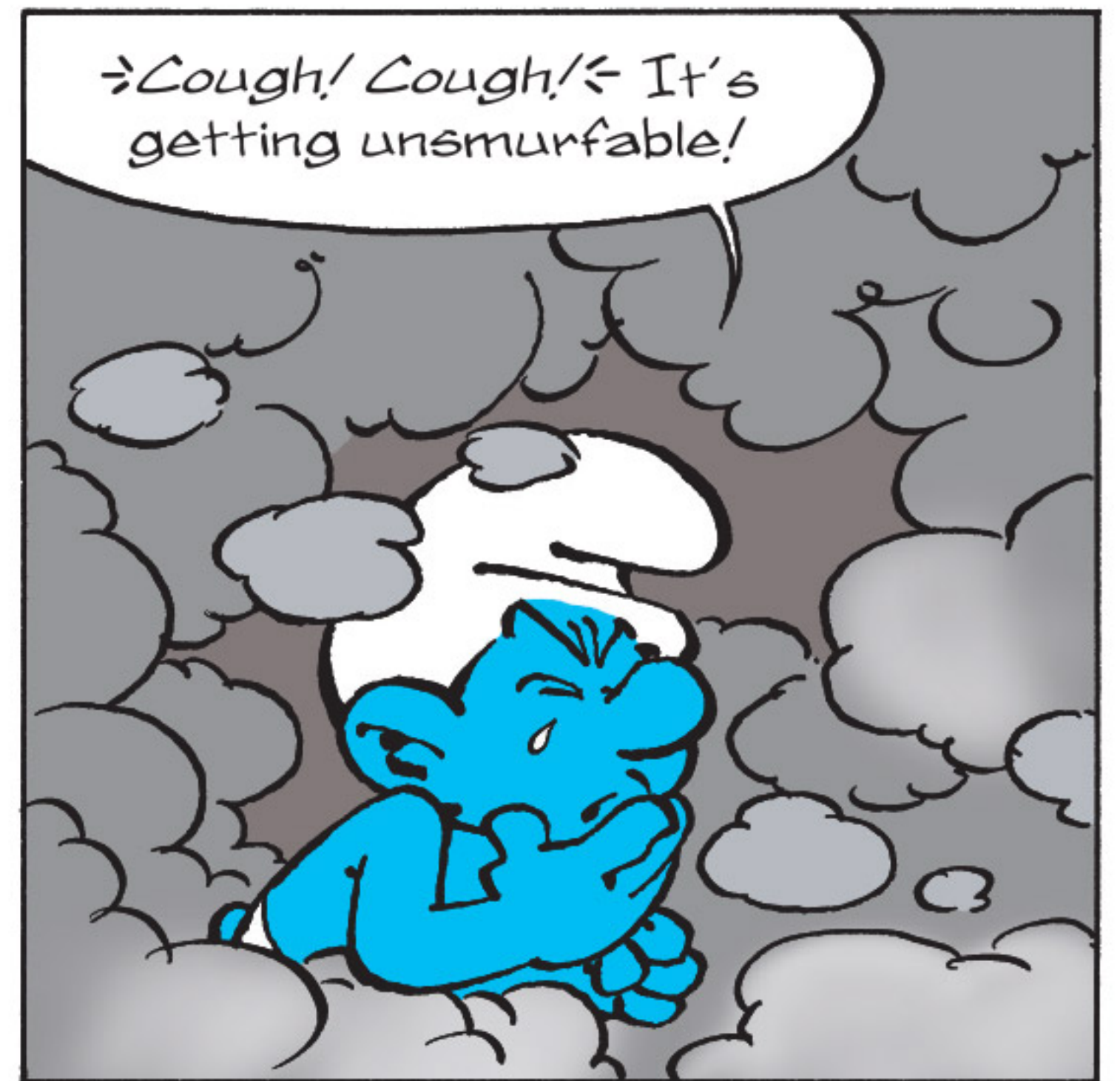


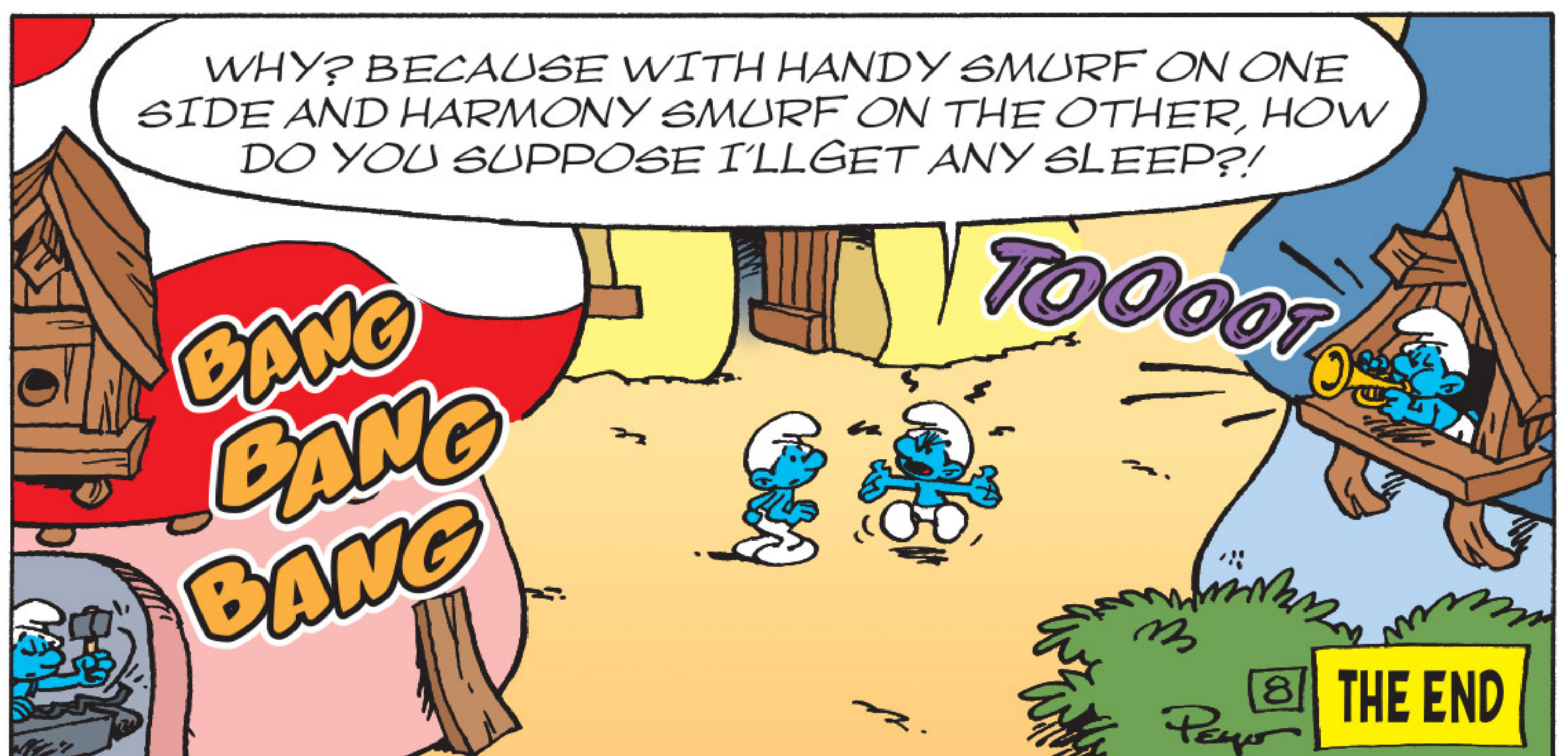
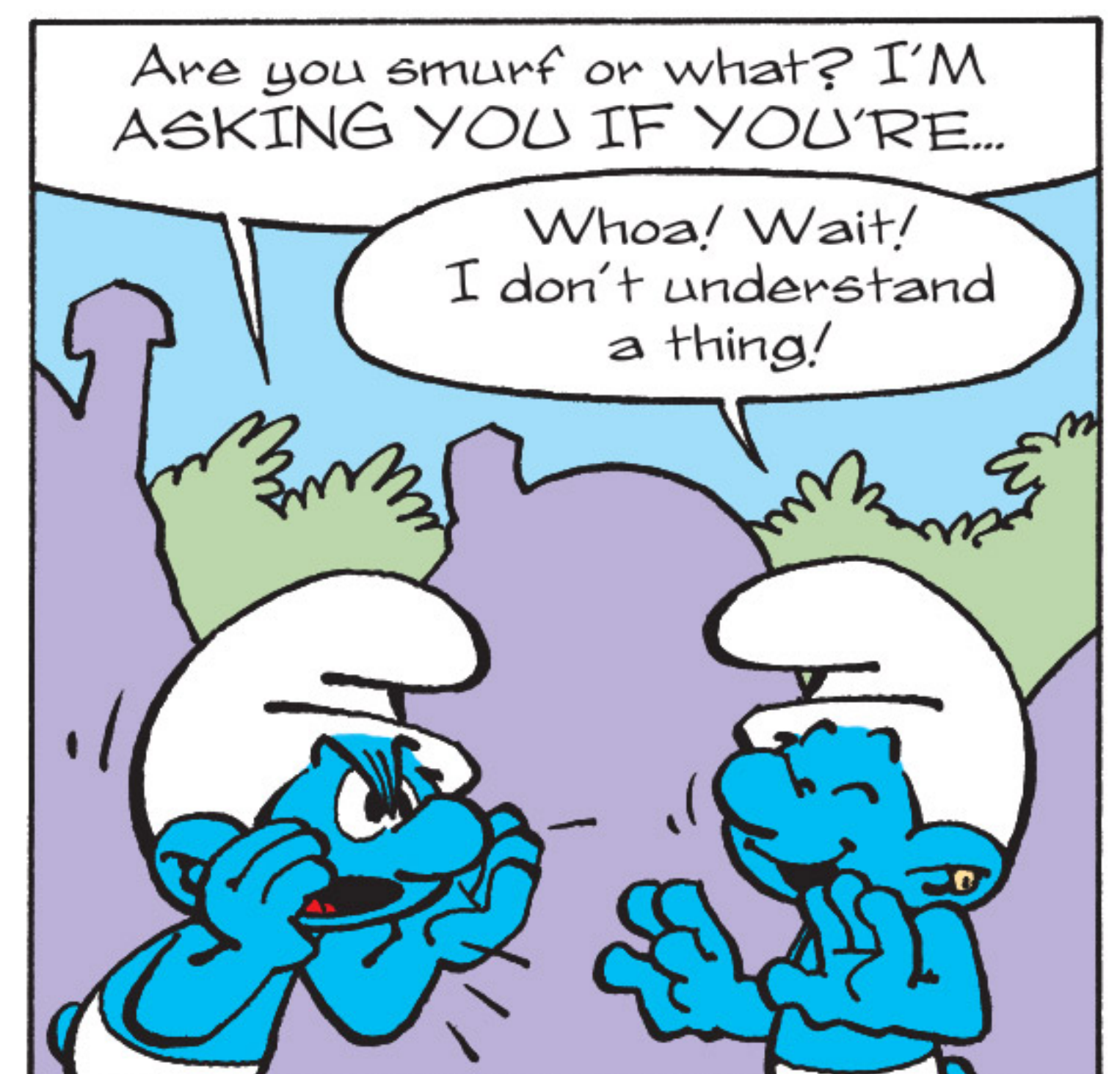
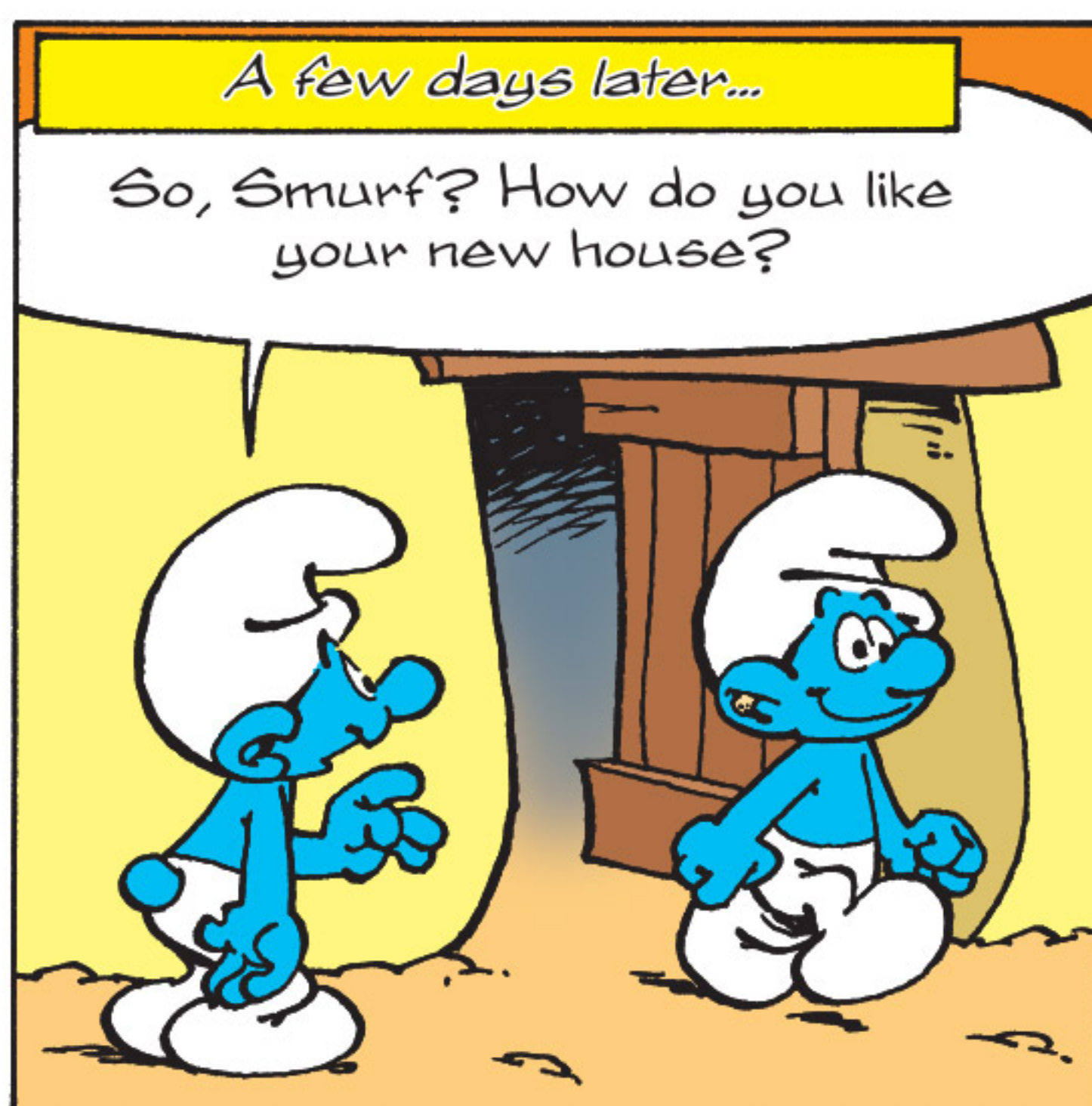
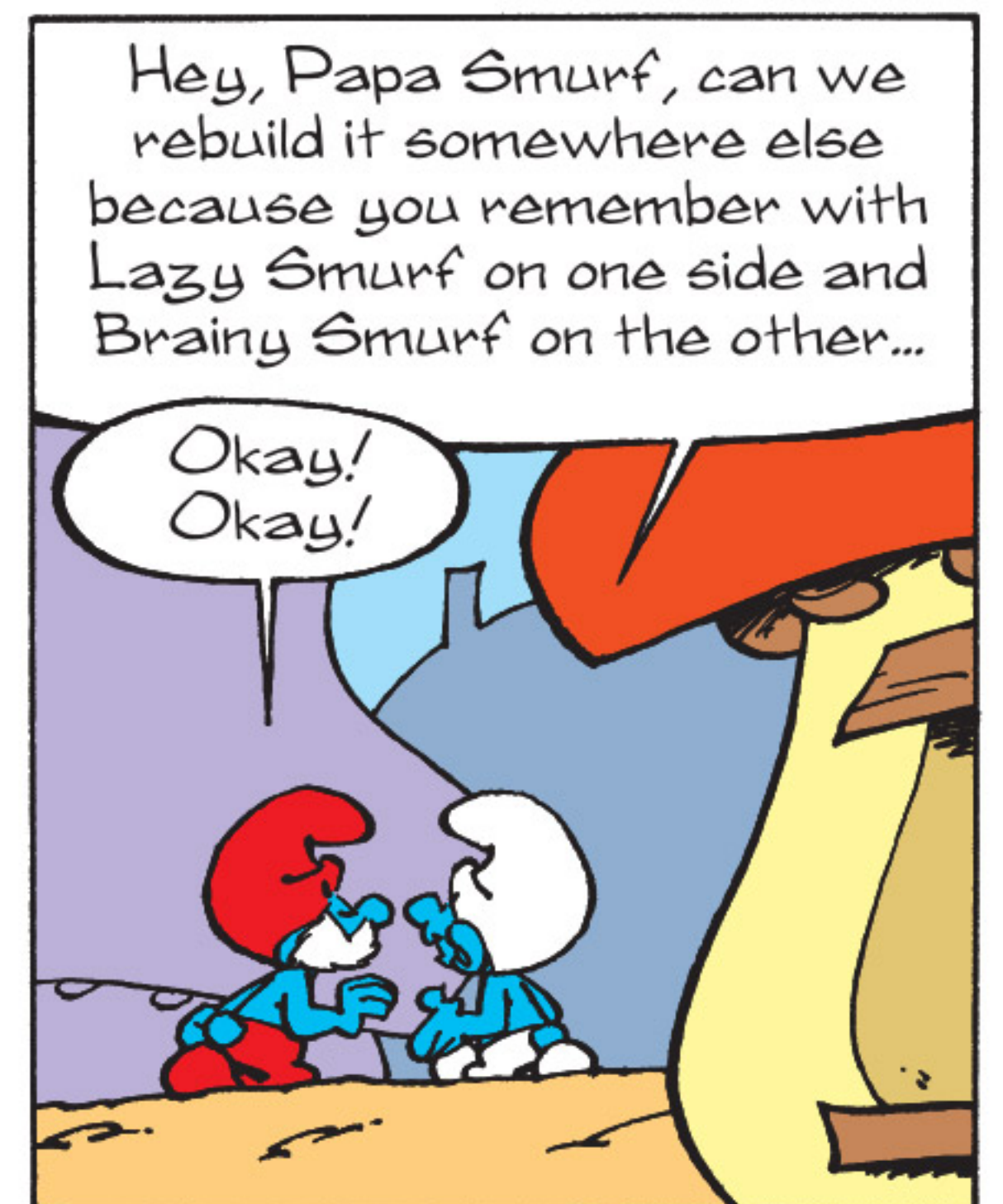
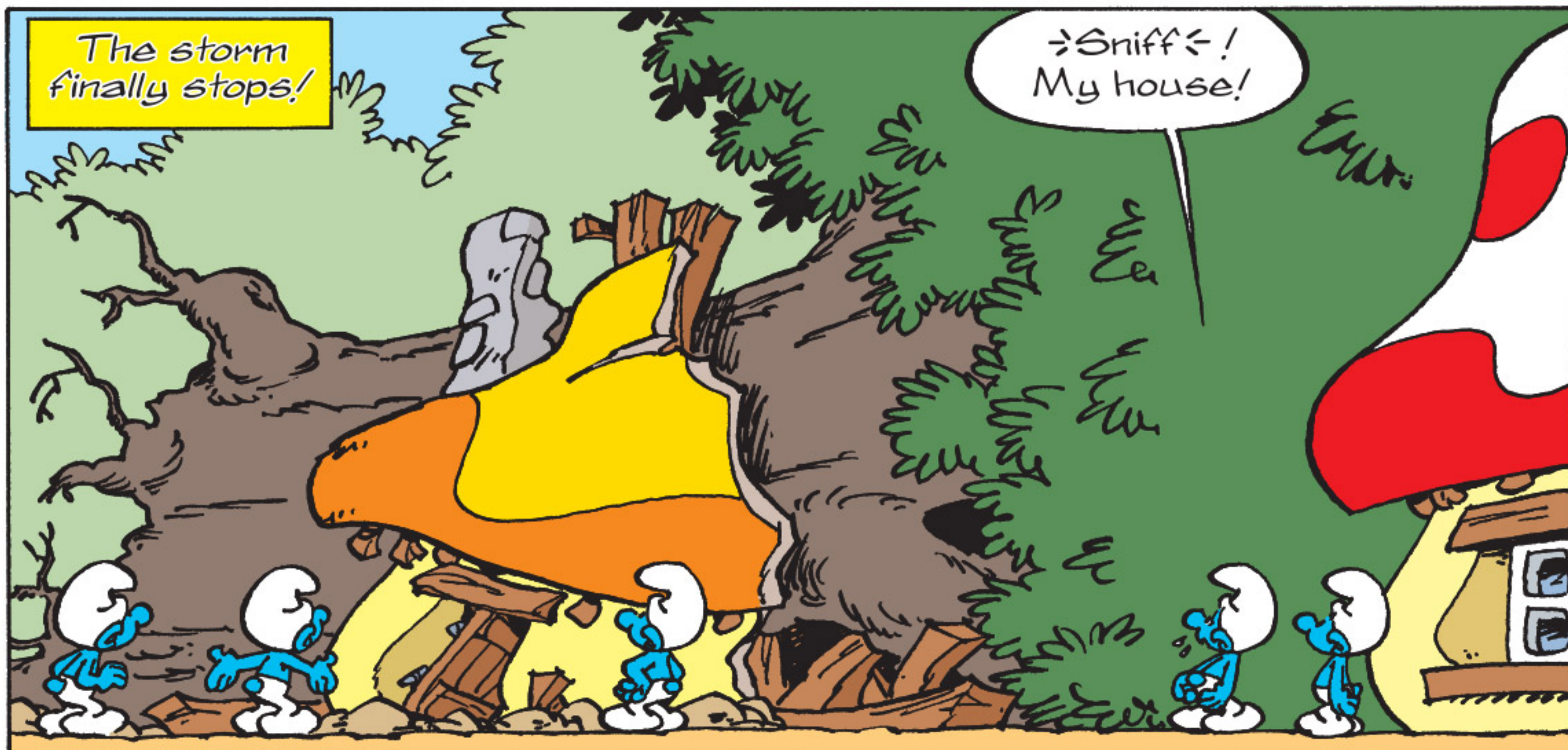












WATCH OUT FOR PAPERCUTZ ™

Welcome to the first *Smurfs* graphic novel from Papercutz, the feisty little graphic novel publisher for all ages. I'm Jim Salicrup, the Smurf-in-Chief, and all of us here at Papercutz are thrilled to be bringing back the classic *Smurfs* comics by Peyo to a North American audience. Not everyone realizes that the *Smurfs* originally appeared in comics, and were later adapted into animated films and TV series, not to mention toys. In fact, the *Smurfs* made their debut in a graphic album called "Johan et Pirlouit" in 1958. We decided to publish that historic debut of the *Smurfs*, in our second *Smurfs* graphic novel—"The *Smurfs* and the Magic Flute"—but be warned, that the stars of the story are Johan and Peewit. The *Smurfs* don't appear in the first half of the story. Of course, when they do appear, they're truly magical.

As for this smurfilicious volume, there's an interesting story there too. The original title for the first story is "Les Schtroumpfs Noirs" or "The Black *Smurfs*," and it's never been published in English before. The reason is that there was a concern that the story would be misinterpreted and be found offensive to African-Americans. While we believe that there is nothing at all racist about the story, we can see how the story could very easily be taken the wrong way, especially by children. We decided to follow the lead of the Hanna-Barbera animation studio back when they adapted the story, and simply changed the black *smurfs* to purple *smurfs*. Since this was already done before, in animated form, we like to therefore believe that Peyo would've approved.

If you're wondering about that orange cat who appears on page two of "The Flying Smurf," that's Azrael, the pet of the wicked sorcerer Gargamel. The first story to feature the Smurf's arch foe, "The Smurfnapper," is

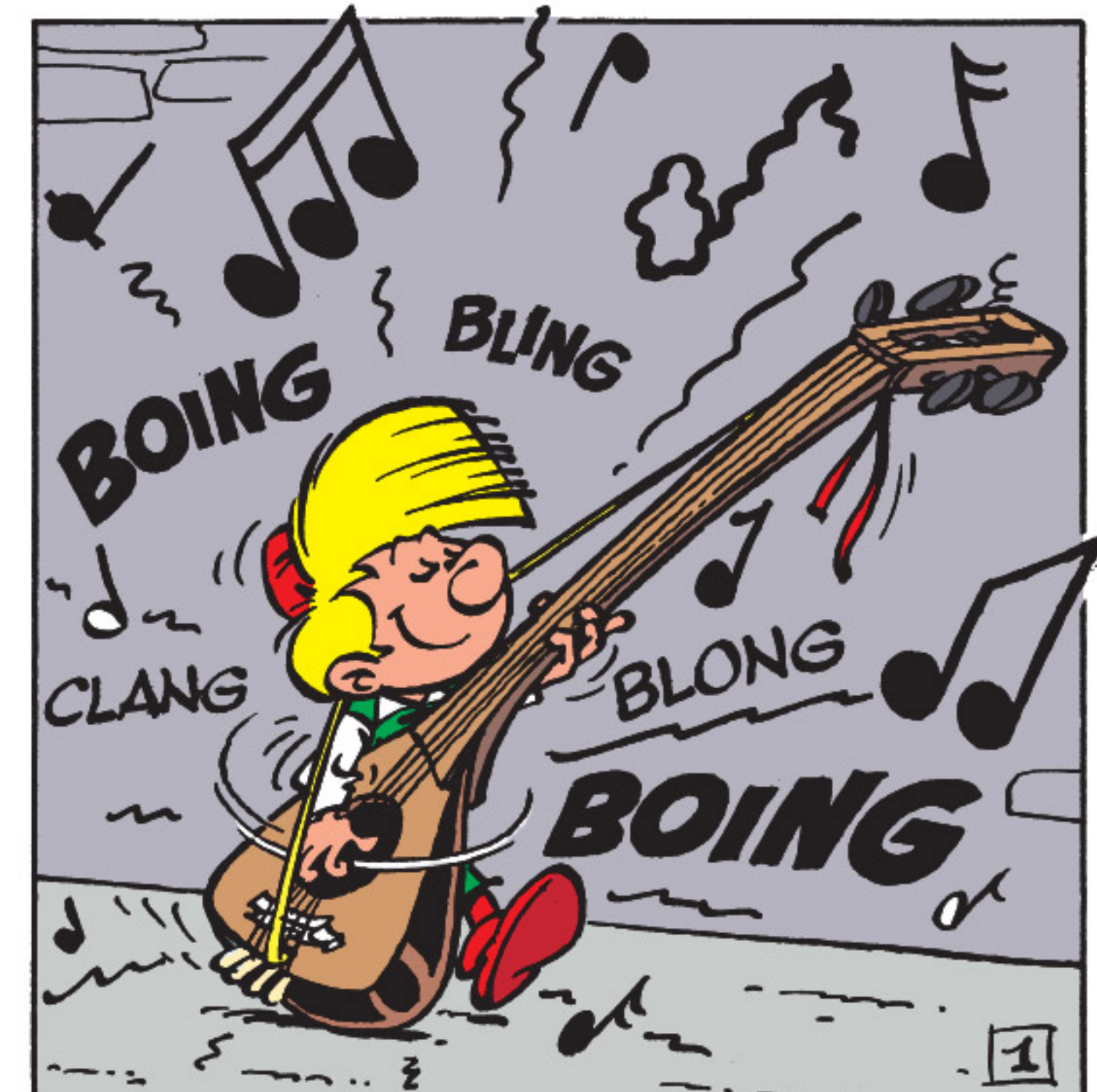
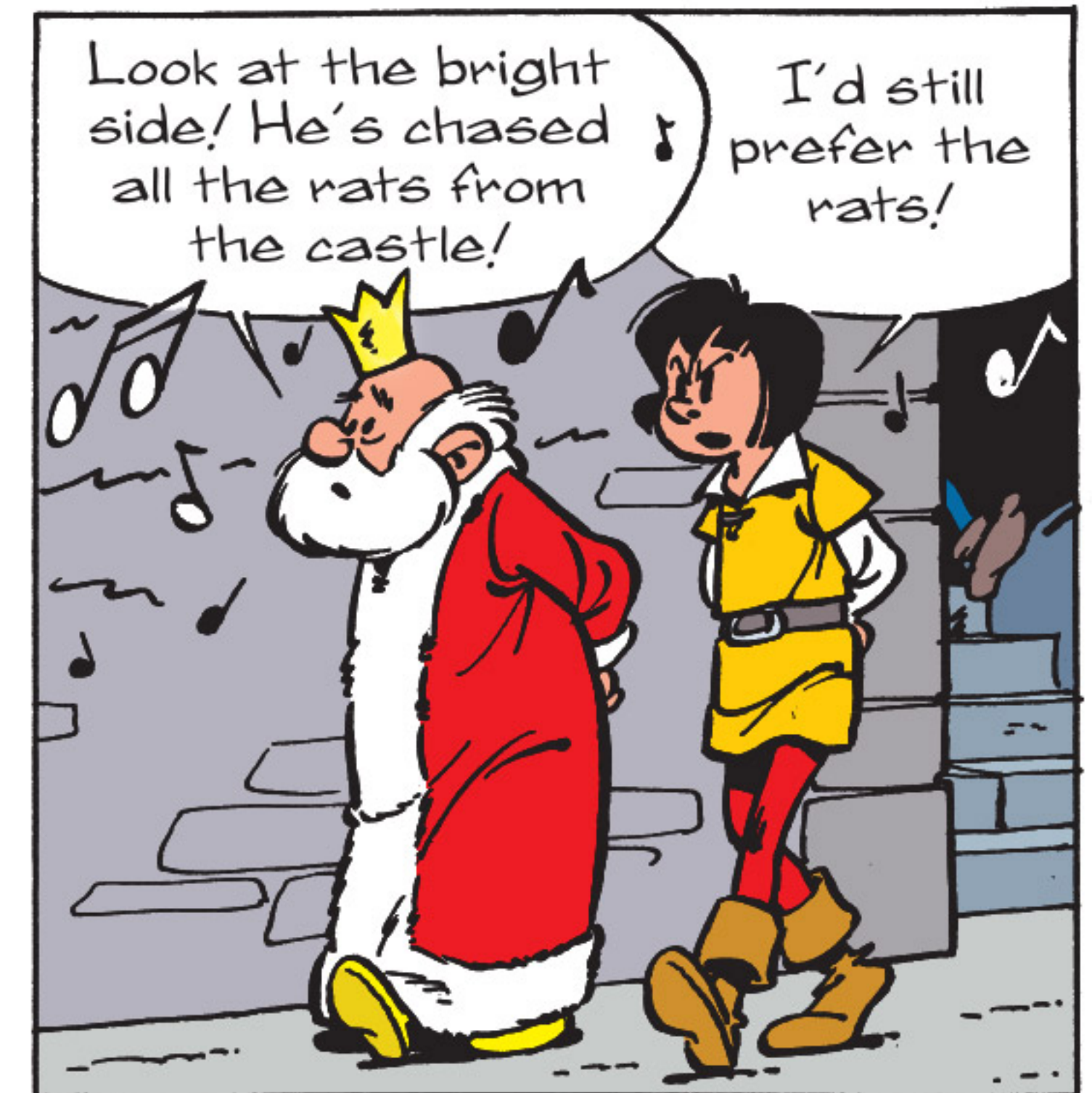
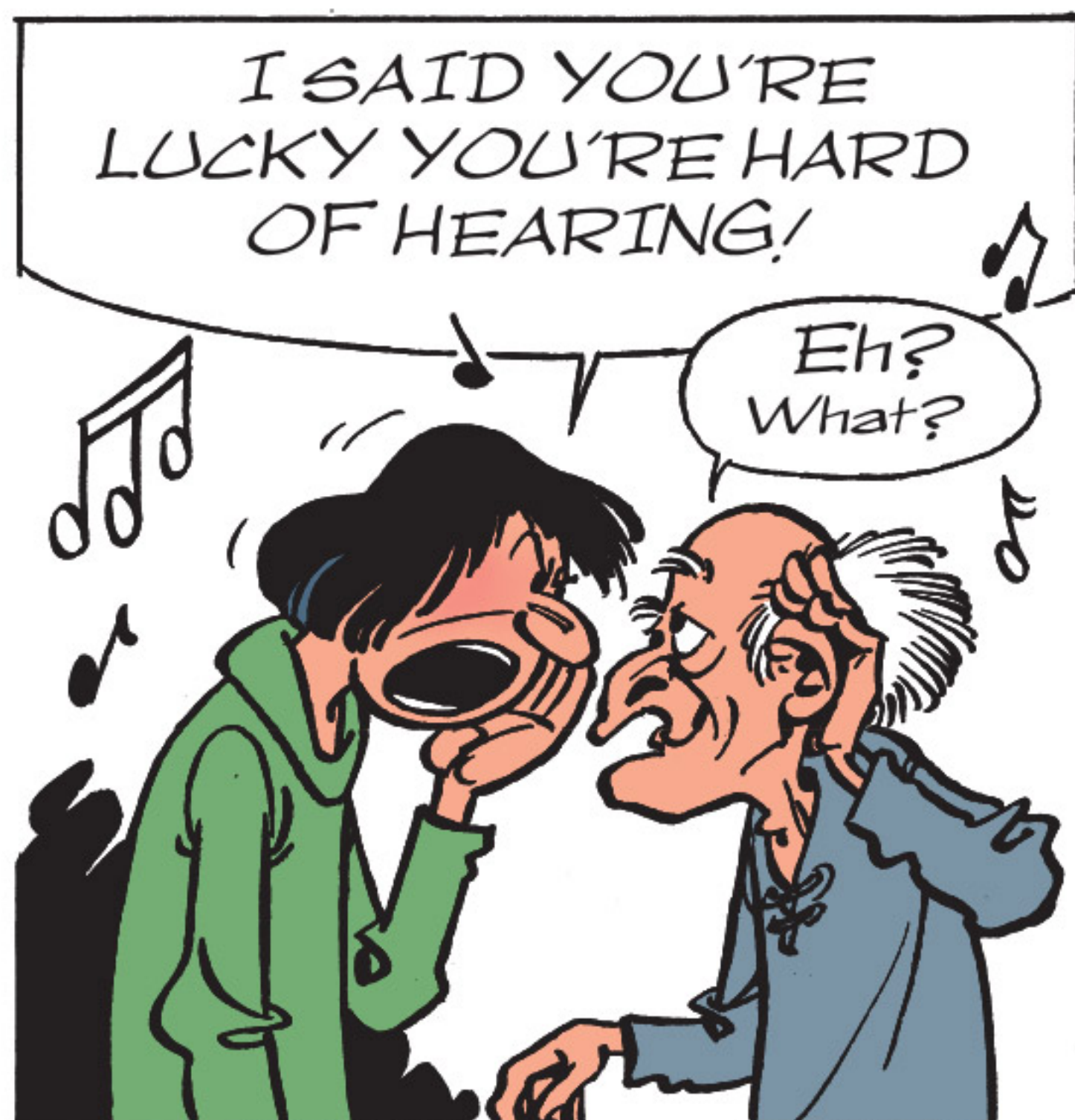
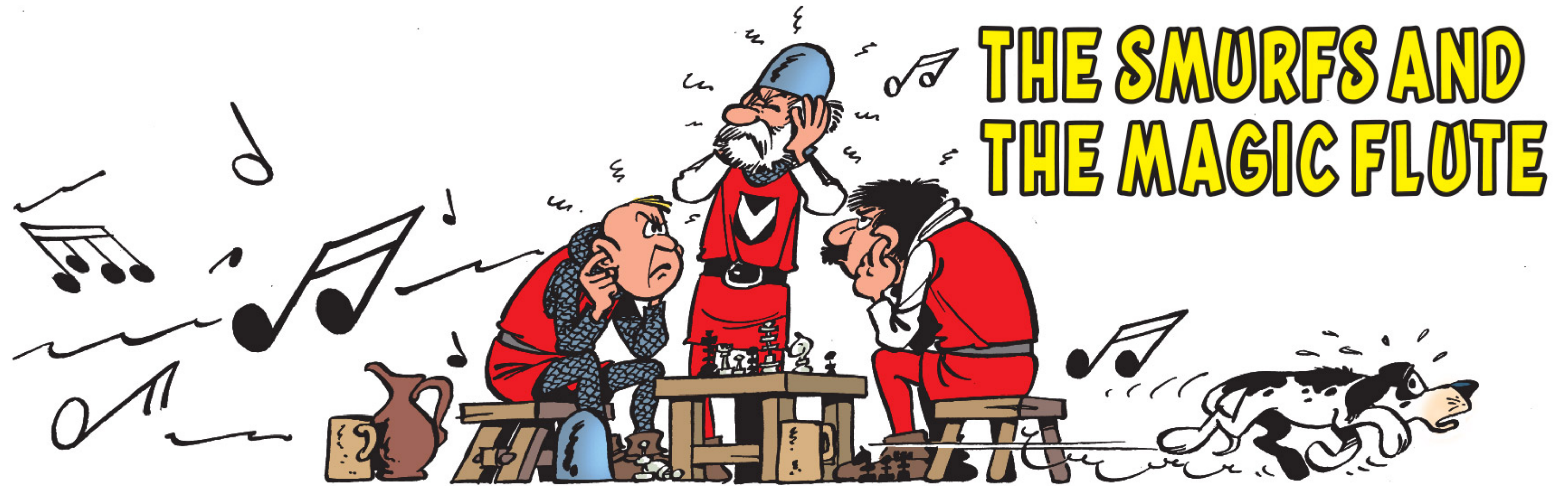
