MAKING A SILK PURSE OUT OF A SMURF'S EAR


Yes, this device I've constructed will allow me to smurf arrows into the target with a lot more power and precision!

I'm Jim Salicrup, your out-of-shape Smurf-in-Chief. Fortunately, thanks to Associate Smurf Michael Petranek, we've got an able-bodied person to do most of the heavy lifting around here.

As Smurf-in-Chief, my main responsibility is to make sure each and every Papercutz edition of THE SMURFS is as Smurfy as possible. That's not too difficult when you're starting out with such Smurftacular material as the original Smurfs comics created by Peyo, and you have such talented and devoted folks such as Lettering Smurfette Janice Chiang (see THE SMURFS #9), Smurfic Designer Adam Grano (See SMURFS #8), and Smurflator Joe Johnson (See SMURFS #10) on your team. But holding it all together, and patiently and politely helping everyone to do their work as painlessly as possible is our very own Associate Smurf Michael Petranek.

Despite having to endure my countless Gargamelian rants, Michael is able to maintain focus on making sure each volume is assembled properly and with special care. You'd be surprised what could potentially go wrong! Azrael could be the wrong shade of orange! Papa Smurf could be saying dialogue intended for the Smurfette! Brainy Smurf could open a present from Jokey Smurf that doesn't explode! And, if on those rare occasions a minor boo-boo does slip through, it's Michael who makes sure it's corrected in the next printing.

But who is this mysterious Mr. Petranek? Michael Petranek denies that he was born in the Smurf's Village, and insists he was born in someplace called Dallas, Texas. It was there that Michael began his intense study of the comicbook artform by grabbing every comicbook he could get his hands on... legally. He also claims to play several musical instruments, but then again, so does Harmony Smurf. He has also directed theatrical plays and short films, so he truly is a very creative guy. But despite his closeness to Broadway and to several major comicbook publishers in New York City, Michael still gets homesick for his family, including his "little brother," an eighty-

If only Michael could actually be in the Smurfs Village, he'd be able to keep things happy and fun, unlike what happens there in SMURFS #12 "Smurf Vs. Smurf."
