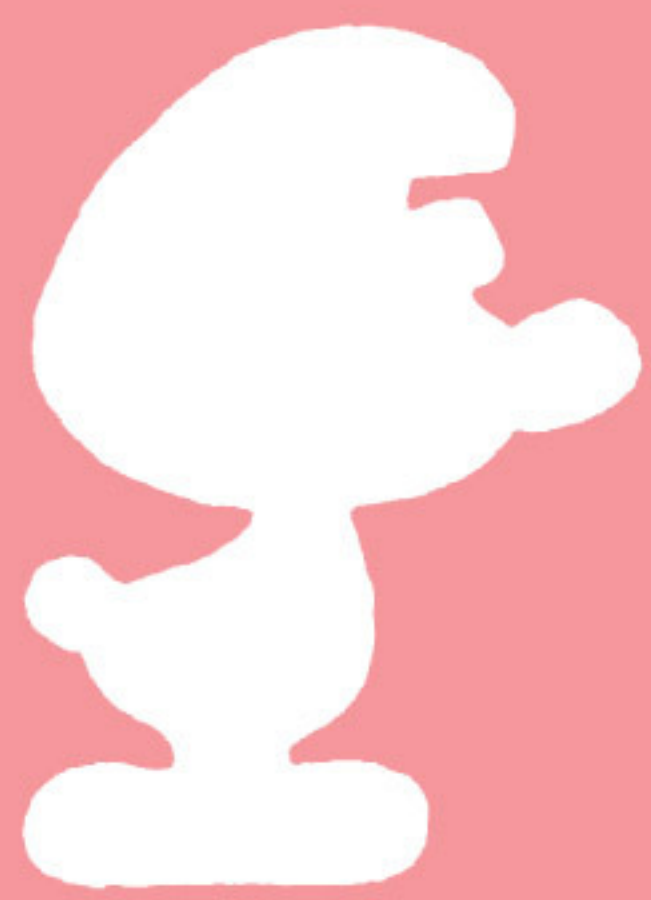












WATCH OUT FOR PAPERCUTZ



Welcome to the fabulous FOREVER SMURFETTE graphic novel from Papercutz, the Smurf-sized company dedicated to publishing great graphic novels for all ages. I'm your humble Smurf-in-Chief, Jim Salicrup, who is here to offer a little smurfy history and background...

THE SMURFS actually began over 50 years ago, not as animated cartoons nor toys nor movie stars, but as comic characters created by cartoonist Pierre Culliford, better known as Peyo. A descendant of the pirate Robert Culliford, Peyo was born in the Brussels commune of Schaerbeek, on June 25, 1928.

After several unsuccessful attempts with pirate comics (*Captain Coky*), Peyo decided to draw what he really loved, stories based in the Middle Ages. He published strips in several dailies. He drew some *Johan* strips for the Belgian daily newspaper *Le Soir* and then for *Spirou* magazine. The King's page, *Johan*, and his friend *Peewit* have fun and countless adventures defending the less-fortunate throughout the kingdom.

For *Johan and Peewit's* ninth graphic novel of adventures, Peyo needed a group of imps to build a magic flute. He remembers a meal he had with his friend André Franquin (*Marsupilami*) when he'd wanted to ask Franquin to pass him the salt. But he couldn't remember the word so he says: "Pass me the ... uhm ... the smurf!" Franquin hands it over and answers: "Here's the smurf. Once you've smurfed with it you can smurf it back to me!" And so the name and language of the little imps were invented and on page 36 of "The Smurfs and the Magic Flute," a small voice suddenly says: "Can't you watch where you put your smurfs? You nearly smurfed me!" Then a blue skinned imp emerges from behind a rock.

And that was the first time anyone ever saw a Smurf!

The audience instantly fell in love with these mischievous and charming beings -- who enjoy having fun, live in mushroom-shaped houses and speak a weird and wonderful language -- and wanted to see more comics featuring the

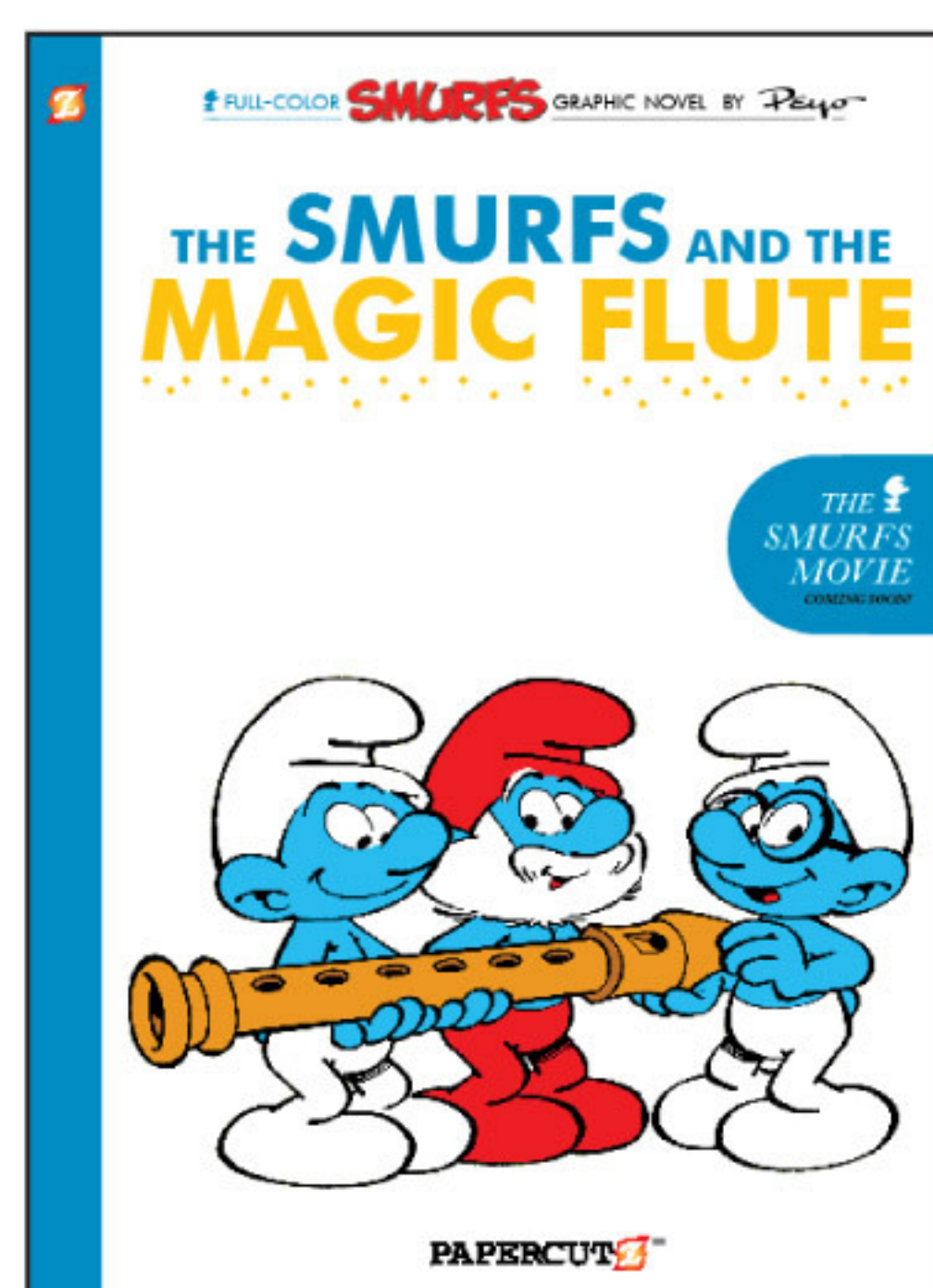
Smurfs. Soon, after several more appearances in the *Johan and Peewit* graphic novels and several Smurfs mini-comics, bound into *Spirou* magazine, the Smurfs were awarded a graphic novel series of their very own.

In the third volume, the Smurfette was created. And the rest is history! All-new SMURFS graphic novels continue to be published to this day. Along the way, the Smurfs became a global sensation, with toys, cartoons, and 3D movies. In 2010, Papercutz became the American publisher of THE SMURFS, as well as other Peyo creations such as *Johan and Peewit*, *Benny Breakiron*, and (coming soon) *Pussycat*.

No matter how far the Smurfs have come, they never seem to forget their roots. For example, in the story "Bombollino Visits the Smurfs," the elf is playing a magical flute—the same flute that appeared in the *Johan and Peewit* story that originally introduced the Smurfs!*

Of course, Smurfette has become a big part of the success of THE SMURFS and is now featured in almost every Smurfs graphic novel published since she was created. But even that isn't quite enough for her legions of fans, and that's why this special edition, starring Smurfette, was put together. We hope you enjoy it, and remember that other comics characters may come and go, but Smurfette is forever!
